Description:

The TT-Force tablet, made by Amicroe in Australia, was a good example of a cheap Android tablet made by an independent small manufacturer, not Apple or Samsung, etc, and not in China.

This tablet had a 400MHz Rockchip 3026 dual-core ARM Cortex-A9 CPU, 8GB of flash memory, 512MB of DDR3 RAM, 802.11 b/n/g WiFi, a 7" TFT LCD screen with 800 x 480 resolution, a microSDcard slot, microphone and speakers, and a 0.3MP 1080p front camera. It had a 2000mAh Li-polymer battery, rechargeable by a 5V 1.5A USB charger.

The speakers were very quiet, which made the tablet unusable for video calls.

The user manual included in this item was a model of clarity on how to use Android 4.2.2 (*JellyBean*).
