## **Description:**

IBM PC DOS, Microsoft MS-DOS, CP/M, CP/M-80, Q-DOS and 86-DOS have a convoluted history [1]. DOS primarily consists of Microsoft's MS-DOS and a related version, IBM PC DOS, both of which were first introduced in 1981, but then had a long history through multiple versions into the new millennium. Both were developed by Microsoft and IBM to execute on the *Intel i8088* of the original *IBM 5150 PC* and to behave in a similar way to Digital Research's CP/M.

IBM PC DOS 2.0, introduced in Mar-1983 for the *IBM PC/XT* [2], represented a watershed in the multiplicity of cross-licensing agreements. IBM PC DOS 2.0 included UNIX-like features such as tree-structured subdirectories for the first time, as well as support for hard disk drives, plus a BIOS with device drivers, and FDISK to create MBR boot records for disk partitioning (FAT12!). IBM's Version 2.1 was an incremental update targeted to their new IBM *PCjr* to allow programs to run from ROM cartridges [3]. Version 2.1 was introduced in Nov-1983.

The item in this collection is thus an early version of the PC DOS software and related documentation, dating from Jan-1984, and is preserved in its original packaging. It comprises an extensive user's manual for PC DOS 2.10, and includes PC DOS 2.10 on 5.25 inch floppy disks, along with supplemental programs Version 3.2 (including LINK.EXE) that date from 12-Mar-1987. Software for the Hercules graphics adapter from 1983 is also included. All the software is on 5.25" floppy disks, see elsewhere in the Software category of this catalog.




Figure 1: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual and software




Figure 2: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual and software




Figure 5: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual and software




Figure 7: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual and software




Figure 8: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 9: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 10: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 11: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 12: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 13: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 15: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 17: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 18: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 19: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 20: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 21: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 22: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 23: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 24: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 25: MSDOS 2.10 User's Manual




Figure 27: Hercules Graphics Card software for MSDOS 2.10
