### **Description:**

This item is t user manual for the C-Pen 800  $3^{rd}$  generation hand-held digital camera based pen-computer that could read and store text in a computer format and transfer it to a PC or phone via IrDA. When the C-Pen 800 was moved over printed text (at up to 100 characters per second), a scanning light was automatically activated, and the text was scanned using built-in OCR and saved into built-in flash memory. It was an enhancement of the C-Pen 200 and 600 products, including a *C Schedule* (Microsoft Outlook-compatible calendar), a text scanner, an alarm function, expanded storage for up to 3,000 pages of printed text and 1,000 addresses, plus a higher definition 7-line display in a pen-shaped device. It could scan direct to Microsoft applications, could act as a pen for direct writing to Microsoft applications. It had *C Message* and *C Address* (address book) features to interface with GSM phones like the Ericsson 888 or Nokia 9110, and a *C Dictionary* could be downloaded into it.

The C-Pen 800 was quite small (140 x 35 x 20 mm) and light (85 grams including 2 x AAA batteries). It included a 100MHz CPU, 512kB of RAM, 8MB of flash memory, and ran a proprietary *ARIPOS* operating system. It was compatible with Microsoft Windows XP, but is unlikely to work with later 64-bit Windows versions (except possibly with the C-Pen software in *Compatibility* mode).




Figure 1: C-Pen 800 User Guide, Front Cover
